

#### WOMANHOOD & WOMEN IN TEACHING

God made women equal in value to man. Women have a unique role in creation and are uniquely equipped to live out God's will next to man. The Bible is clear that the Overseer (the Pastor) of a church is to be the husband of one wife - and thus the Pastor is to be a man. This follows God's design for marriage, in that the man bears the responsibility of the family. The male Pastor bears the responsibility of the church family.
